1 quart fruit juice (not grape)
1 banana, mashed
1/2 cup yogurt

Mix ingredients thoroughly, then pour into cups or molds and freeze. These can be eaten by people too!

Homemade Frosty Paws (from [DachsieHeaven](#))

32 oz vanilla yogurt
1 mashed banana or 1 large jar of baby fruit
2 tablespoons peanut butter
2 tablespoons honey
blend together

Freeze in 3 oz paper cups or ice cube trays. Microwave a few seconds to thaw slightly before serving.

These recipes are a great way to use ripened bananas and dogs love them. However, be sure to check for controversial ingredients along with the recipes; there are some ingredients that can, in large amounts, be deadly to your pet. Sometimes those ingredients may be called for in very small "flavoring" quantities. If you see any of these ingredients in a recipe you'd like to use, consult your veterinarian to see if the recipe is appropriate for your pet. Otherwise, leave the ingredient out or select another recipe! Some potentially harmful ingredients: • Garlic • Onions • Raisins/grapes (including juice)
